(U) Scope Note

(U//FOUO) This Special Event Threat Assessment (SETA) addresses threats to the 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival, taking place on the Michigan International Speedway (MIS) property from 19 – 21 July 2024, in Brooklyn, Michigan. This FBI and Michigan Intelligence Operations Center SETA does not include non-violent civil disobedience tactics (for example, protests without a permit), which are outside the scope of federal law enforcement jurisdiction.

(U//FOUO) FBI Detroit and the Michigan Intelligence Operations Center have prepared the following SETA for the 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival, taking place on the MIS property from 19 – 21 July 2024 in Brooklyn, Michigan, to assist security planners and law enforcement personnel in monitoring threat information and maintaining a safe and secure event environment. Information in this assessment is current and accurate as of 28 June 2024.

(U) Key Findings

(U//FOUO) As of 28 June 2024, FBI Detroit and the Michigan Intelligence Operations Center have no information to indicate a specific or credible threat to, or associated with, the 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival, taking place on the MIS property from 19 – 21 July 2024, in Brooklyn, Michigan.

(U//FOUO) Although there is no specific threat reporting at this time, the potential risk posed to the 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival by an unmanned aircraft system (UAS) remains a concern. UASs pose a potential risk to performers, spectators, attendees, and security personnel at the event. This is based on a review of open source and law enforcement information detailing how individuals have used UASs to conduct surveillance of US law enforcement, facilitate terrorist or criminal activity, and disrupt mass gatherings. The Islamic State of Iraq and ash-Sham (ISIS) have also weaponized UASs as improvised explosive devices (IEDs) overseas, a tactic HVEs or domestic extremists could replicate to deliver a weaponized payload over mass gatherings in the United States.

(U//FOUO) Additionally, the potential risk posed to the 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival by an active shooter remains a concern. Any potential terrorist or lone offender attacks against a soft target, such as an open public event, may come without warning. The mass shooting that occurred in July 2022 at the 4th of July parade in Highland Park, Illinois and the shooting on 1

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October 2017 at a country music festival in Las Vegas, Nevada, highlight the vulnerability of large crowds to a motivated lone offender committed to conducting an attack.

(U//FOUO) The threat of unaffiliated lone offenders^a and homegrown violent extremists^b (HVEs) are of particular concern due to their ability to remain undetected until operational. Lone offenders often pose a risk due to their willingness to attack civilians and soft targets; their ability to inflict significant casualties with weapons, which do not require specialized knowledge, access, or training; and their unpredictability, as witnessed in attacks in Orlando, Florida, and San Bernardino, California in 2016 and 2015 respectively.

(U//FOUO) FBI Detroit remains concerned about the sustained interest by terrorists in targeting mass gatherings. Al-Qa'ida, ISIS, and their affiliates remain intent on attacking Western targets and continue to call on individuals to conduct independent attacks in the United States using a variety of weapons and tactics, including vehicle ramming, IEDs, improvised incendiary devices (IIDs), edged weapons, and small arms. Examples such as the ISIS Khorasan (ISIS-K) attack on the Moscow Crocus City Concert Hall on 22 March 2024 and the 22 May 2017, suicide bomber IED attack at an Ariana Grande concert inside the Manchester Arena in Manchester, England, have also heightened concern about similar attacks. To date, these attacks have focused on soft targets, such as sporting events, music venues, shopping districts, and mass-transportation systems.

(U) Event Overview

(U//FOUO) The 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival is a three-day country music festival held on the MIS property in Brooklyn, Michigan, with events beginning Friday, 19 July 2024 and ending Sunday, 21 July 2024. The event consists of over 31 performances, which include many high-profile entertainers in country music. The festival site is located behind the backstretch of the MIS. The 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival expects over 40,000 spectators for the 3 day event with a large number of those spectators also staying in the 1,200 acres of camping spaces surrounding the venue.

(U) SEAR Level

(U//FOUO) The 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival is designated as a special event assessment rating (SEAR) 4.

^a (U//FOUO) The FBI and DHS define a lone offender as an individual motivated by one or more violent extremist ideologies who, operating alone supports or engages in acts of violence in furtherance of that ideology or ideologies that may involve influence from a larger terrorist organization or a foreign actor.

^b (U//FOUO) The FBI and DHS define an HVE as a person of any citizenship who has lived or operated primarily in the United States or its territories who advocates, is engaged in, or is preparing to engage in ideologically motivated terrorist activities (including providing support to terrorism) in furtherance of political or social objectives promoted by a foreign terrorist organization, but whose actions are independent of direction by a foreign terrorist organization. HVEs are distinct from traditional domestic terrorists who engage in unlawful acts of violence to intimidate civilian populations or attempt to influence domestic policy without direction from or influence from a foreign actor.

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(U) Potential Threat Indicators

(U//FOUO) Absent a specific, actionable threat to the 2024 Faster Horses Music Festival, we are providing indicators to aid law enforcement and first responders in identifying and mitigating threats. The totality of behavioral indicators and other relevant circumstances should be evaluated when considering any law enforcement response or action. (Note: Behaviors associated with the below indicators can include constitutionally protected activities. The FBI does not initiate any investigative activity based solely on the exercise of First Amendment activities or on the race, ethnicity, national origin, or religion of the subject, or a combination of only such factors.)

(U//FOUO) Possible indicators of pre-operational surveillance or attack planning include:

- (U//FOUO) Unusual or prolonged interest in or attempts to gain sensitive information about security measures of personnel, entry points, peak days and hours of operation, and access controls such as alarms or locks.
- (U//FOUO) Observation of security reaction drills or procedures, or multiple false alarms or fictitious emergency calls to same locations or similar venues.
- (U//FOUO) Discreet use of cameras or video recorders, sketching, or note-taking consistent with pre-operational surveillance.
- (U//FOUO) Interest in speaking with building maintenance personnel.
- (U//FOUO) Observation of or questions about facility security measures, including barriers, restricted areas, cameras, and intrusion detection systems.
- (U//FOUO) Observations of or questions about facility air conditioning, heating, and ventilation systems.
- (U//FOUO) Suspicious purchases of dual-use items which could be used to construct an explosive device, including hydrogen peroxide, acetone, gasoline, propane, or fertilizer.
- (U//FOUO) Suspicious activities in storage facilities or other areas, which could be used to construct an explosive device.
- (U//FOUO) Attempted or unauthorized access to rooftops or other potentially sensitive areas.

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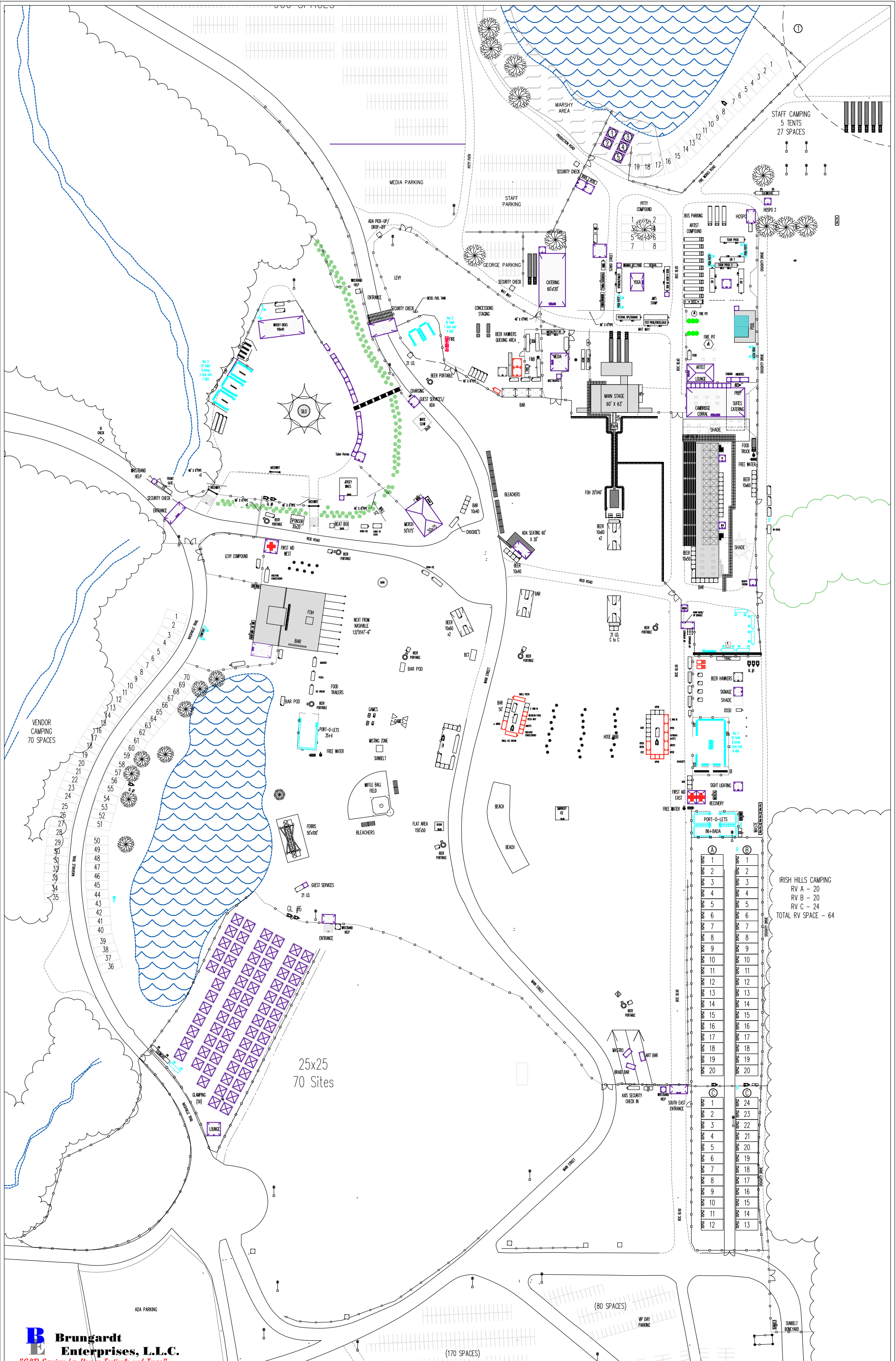
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National Weather Service Weather Briefing as of 7/16/2023
